STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW DISCLOSURE

The federal Student-Right-To-Know Act requires institutions to make completion rates available upon request to prospective students and other interested parties. The Act defines the cohort of students on which the institution must report. This cohort is comprised of “first time, full-time, degree-seeking” students in the institution’s fall term that completed their program of study within 150% of their program length.

The rates reflect the graduation/completion of students who enrolled September 1, 2010 – August 31, 2011 and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed. These numbers represent the Graduation rates of these students as of August 31, 2014.

While reviewing this information, please bear in mind:

- Graduation rate is based on 3 years of attendance that equates to 150% of our longest program.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
