The only way to assure this is for all proposed investigations by any Arizona College student, staff or faculty; or involving any Arizona College students, staff or faculty to be submitted, along with the appropriate information forms, to the Institutional Review Board (IRB).

To fail to submit any proposed research to the IRB is a violation of Arizona College policy. Whether you already have a degree and are a veteran researcher or this is your first research effort, this site is designed to help you prepare your study for IRB review and approval. In this section, are the information and tools needed to help you understand what is involved when you conduct research with human subjects or access any of their information. I hope that you find the information on this website both helpful and educational.
